

It is with the greatest passion for our Lord Jesus Christ, our Constitution, and compassion for my fellow American citizens that I provide a written statement on the harms and unconstitutionality of the Equality Act.

My name is Daren Mehl. I was created by God as a heterosexual male. I believe The Equality Act will harm me if it is passed and becomes law because it will interfere with my inalienable rights of religious practice and free speech.

To understand the claims I have about The Equality Act you must understand my journey of faith in Jesus Christ. Let me briefly tell my testimony of Jesus Christ:

Having been relentlessly teased by girls and boys in elementary and high school as a sissy, pansy, girly boy, gay, queer, and other pejoratives, I began to embrace the thought that perhaps they were right, I was gay. So I did what is common among many bullied people, I took the humiliation of being called gay and made it my identity, believing it would rob them of their strength and lose its power over me. However, in hindsight, adopting the homosexual identity became a power over me that led me away from Jesus Christ. And so I found I chose homosexuality as an identity and sodomy as the means to access what I thought was love.

Even though I was a confessing Christian at the time of choosing a homosexual identity and behaviors, I couldn't reconcile that choice with the teachings of Jesus Christ. I knew it wasn't a matter of misreading scripture, it was plain. Trying to accept a reinterpretation of scripture failed because I was also baptised with the Holy Spirit, the spirit of Truth. So for a time I chose to merge homosexuality and Christianity into a vain imaginary 'gay Christian' identity and lifestyle. I tried this identity and belief merger by ignoring what I read in the Bible where sodomy is called a sin and that practicing homosexuals do not inherit the Kingdom of God. I also adopted an imaginary belief not found in the bible, but taught to me by the LGBTQ affirming church, that I was created gay by God and couldn't change and didn't need to because it was a gift from God. With these in mind I hoped perhaps I could reconcile the conflict and so I lived this way for 8 years.

I attended gay affirming church and had several serial "romantic" and "monogamous" relationships with men practicing sodomy as an outward expression of what I believed at the time was love for them.

By the grace of Jesus Christ, because of a close friend choosing to share deep truths about God from his own journey with Jesus and the grace of God given to him, I was led to begin a healing journey with Jesus. Jesus took me back to my childhood and started removing the barbs that were tied around my identity and causing me pain.

As Jesus worked on my heart and mind over several years, I asked God to be made righteous according to God's standards through faith in Jesus Christ. By the mercy and grace of God, Jesus Christ delivered me into His righteousness and taught me how to live righteously in the Spirit. God also gave me grace through faith in Jesus Christ resulting in **persistent** change of identity, desires, and behavior. I experienced change from exclusive homosexual desires to exclusive heterosexual desires. Jesus did this through at least a dozen sovereign interventions such as giving me grace to forgive those who bullied and shamed me, led me to being disciplined by reading the Bible and other testimony/discipleship books (some now banned by Amazon in the name of LGBTQ equality), speaking to Christian licensed therapists, prayer with others, and receiving pastoral care. All of

which today according to the Equality Act would be labeled as 'discredited practice known as 'conversion therapy', maligning my sincere faith in Jesus Christ and the testimony of His work..

When I accepted the homosexual identity, I had to give up my boyhood dream of being married to a woman and having children. But by the miracle of God, Jesus Christ restored that dream and now I've been married to my wife Rhoda, a female woman, since Dec 11, 2005, and we have a male son, Sebastian, born in 2013, and a female daughter, Esther, who was born in 2015.

I have experienced my romantic and sexual desires restored to heterosexual orientation, and in doing so I believe they are rightly ordered in righteousness and holiness before God. I have been given a family of my own and affirmed as a man and image bearer of God. I believe all this was the redeeming and sanctifying work of Jesus Christ. I can attribute these miracles and the sustaining power to no other.

The irony of my testimony of Jesus Christ that I just shared, in context of The Equality Act, is that it would be labeled as ex-gay ministry, aka "discredited 'conversion therapy'", and therefore categorized as disproven, discredited, harmful, and discriminatory against the LGBTQ community.

The government has no authority to establish the LGBTQ religious beliefs that one is born gay and cannot change, nor to declare the work of Jesus Christ in my life as disproven and discredited, or that seeking Jesus, who said He is the way, the truth, and the life, to be harmful and discriminatory. The Equality Act would do a great harm to my freedom to live my faith as a licensed minister of the Gospel of Jesus where I am called to make disciples of all mankind. This requires testimony, evangelism, discipleship of people who want to leave the LGBTQ cult to follow Christ..

I believe I will be harmed as well as others like me by The Equality Act as it will embolden the already biased medical associations, the LGBTQ religious belief affirming ones, the ones who see Christianity as a religious stigma to be avoided, will likely put into their practices the "science" sufficient to justify a diagnosis of my religious beliefs as an illness and recommend treatments to deprogram me from religious dogma. This may sound hyperbolic, but I have been criticized by LGBTQ activists and this claim has been thrown at me as a way to 'cure' me of my Christianity.

Many statements have already made by LGBTQ leaders and these medical associations suggesting that ex-gays are just suffering from 'internalized homophobia' or are victims of stigma created by religion and therefore denying our 'true selves'. I am not denying my authentic self, I have found it in Jesus Christ. I am not suffering from stigma created by Christians, but rather I do suffer persecution by the LGBTQ cult followers.

I am a licensed minister of the gospel of Jesus Christ. The Equality Act would have an effect to chill my free speech and the free exercise of my Christian religious belief to 'go and make disciples of men'. I would not be able to provide pastoral care for those who as seeking to align their behaviors and identity to the teachings of Jesus Christ.

The Equality Act would carve out a community of self identified people, those who identify as LGBTQ, and prevent me from discipling them in the Christian faith. Scripture says to go and make disciples of 'all' people, I believe that to mean all people, even those who have isolated themselves in the LGBTQ community and identity. According to The Equality Act, offering to disciple someone leaving the LGBTQ community and identity would be treated as 'conversion therapy' and be prohibited and considered discriminatory. God desires all to be reconciled to Him. Who am I not to

live out in my calling? No law can stop God's power to bring the Gospel to all people, and I will not stop.

Why does the government get to decide for the LGBTQ identified people that they are not allowed to hear The Gospel or choose to become Christian disciples? In effect, that's what The Equality Act does. It chills, if not prevents, conversion from LGBTQ religious beliefs to Christian beliefs.

If sexual orientation and gender identity defines LGBTQ in the Equality Act, my faith in Jesus Christ defines me in the Civil Rights Act. My faith should be treated equal under the law. Yet the Equality Act turns my faith into discrimination? May it not be so! Sharing the Gospel message is the commandment from my Lord Jesus Christ to share with everyone, it leads to life, and it is GOOD NEWS, not discrimination. Why does the Equality Act in spirit work against my faith and make it unlawful to disciple LGBTQ identified people? What interest does the government have in preventing LGBTQ people from converting to Christianity? Why does the government choose the LGBTQ beliefs to be the state's approved religious standard and prohibit my beliefs? Why can't I live out my faith and speak as I am led by God as guaranteed by the First Amendment?

What is the test for religious discrimination if not the discrimination based on the message of the sincerely held belief? I sincerely believe I am heterosexual male created by God and that Jesus was the one who delivered me from sin, from homosexuality, from the LGBTQ community and made me a member of His kingdom and a son in His royal family. My work as a licensed minister will become prohibited and The Equality Act explicitly states I cannot use Religious Freedom Restoration Act as a defense. It is tacitly admitting the goal of the Act is to impact religious practice and prevent it. And so it is targeting my religious belief to deny my Civil Rights and my First Amendment Rights to free speech and free practice of my Christian faith. "You Hypocrites!" What a double standard The Equality Act" would be.

My Christian faith will be discriminated against even more with the passing of The Equality Act. There is nothing equal about it. Our civil rights will be decimated to the point of no return. We aren't just being sent to the back of the bus in our country, we'll be told to get off the bus. And then we'll be denied being able to purchase parts to build our own bus. If by some miracle we can build a bus, we won't be allowed to drive where we want to go. All the roads will lead to LGBTQ religion.

The Equality Act will harm me and our community of ex-LGBTQ Christians (Christians formerly identified as LGBTQ) if it is passed into law. Where is our equality? Are some more equal than others?

On a more practical note, let's review the language of the act and the risk it has to our freedoms as Americans and the threat to my role as a parent and licensed minister of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

EQUALITY ACT Criminalizes traditional marriage beliefs

“For example, discrimination against a married same-sex couple could be based on the sex stereotype that marriage should only be between heterosexual couples, the sexual orientation of the two individuals in the couple, or both.” Equality Act Sec 2(a)(2)

The equality act will criminalize holding the belief that marriage is exclusively between a man and a woman. Even in the text of the act here, they don't even argue that marriage is between a man and a woman, but frame it as for heterosexual couples only. I was gay identified, a homosexual, when I married my wife who was queer. Marriage is not about 'love', though that is spiritually what it is about, but as far as the government is concerned, it's about protecting children and bringing stability to a society by protecting the family unit that has withstood time since creation. Homosexual identified men ALWAYS had the same RIGHTS as heterosexual men to marry. Both gay or straight men could marry women. I was gay identified, I married a woman.

If the Equality Act were to pass, I would be required to perform gay “marriages” since I also perform real marriages between individuals of complimentary sexes.

The Equality Act abolishes the First Amendment along with Religious Freedom Restoration Act

“SEC. 1107. CLAIMS. “The Religious Freedom Restoration Act of 1993 (42 U.S.C. 2000bb et seq.) shall not provide a claim concerning, or a defense to a claim under, a covered title, or provide a basis for challenging the application or enforcement of a covered title.”

The Equality Act attacks my religious freedoms under the First Amendment as well as removes all protections for my practice of faith where it intersects LGBTQ cult religious beliefs. It effectively nullifies every argument I make under the First Amendment and allows for the state to establish the LGBTQ secular humanist belief system and criminalize my own.

The recent pro-lgbtq supreme court findings are not final, and the LGBTQ lobby wants to get the law changed as fast as possible so the nuances of sex/gender identity are not tried in the supreme court again. They know that there are a LOT of issues with the LGBTQ cult religion that flies in the face of the Constitution and our inalienable rights and so with a single (bad) win at the supreme court they want to change the laws to do away with distinguishing sex in the law. They want to do away with men and women. They think that will bring 'equality' but really it brings harm on so many levels to society.

For example, the LGBTQ lobby and their sycophant government supporters KNOW the conversion therapy bans are unconstitutional.



The Equality Act Wrongly Requires Recognition of LGBTQ as a distinct immutable people

The equality act defines LGBTQ as “Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer” but they left off “questioning” which is a common “orientation”. They use this term to include those who are


questioning their sexuality. However, the Equality Act would require people to go gay, they could never go straight.

The definition of homosexual orientation is sexual or romantic attractions to the same sex. There is no scientific evidence that sexual or romantic attractions are innate or genetic. These are feelings and emotions and how they are interpreted and acted upon is directly tied to someone's religious views about what it means to be human and the purpose of relationships therein. In fact, the LGBTQ lobby knows that their claim that homosexual desires are innate and cannot change is a lie. Lisa Diamond, "On a political level, we have advocated for the civil rights of LGBT people on the basis of them being LGBT. We've used categories as a part of our strategy for social policy and for acceptance. And that is really really tricky now that we know that is not true. [...] I feel that as a community the queers have to stop saying "please help us, we are born this way and cannot change" as an argument for legal standing. I don't think we need that argument and that argument is

Sexual orientation is not immutable, it can change, gender identity is 100% subjective between the person and those who observe them. Each observer may have a completely different view of their sex/gender identity. I for one can see a man in drag and know he is a man, that is his sex. I do not know, by looking at

him, if he identifies as a cross dressing man, or as a woman. I wouldn't know unless I asked. And I have no obligation to honor his assertions regardless. I will keep to my own convictions.

Invasion of Privacy - Privacy a right - Women's Shelters, Locker rooms, Bathrooms

(2) (with respect to gender identity) an individual shall not be denied access to a shared facility, including a restroom, a locker room, and a dressing room, that is in accordance with the individual's gender identity."; and (3) by inserting after section 1105 the following...:

The Equality Act will harm women by allowing men to identify as women and gain access to women's shelters. Shelters separated by sex are an important feature to allow the safety and mental health of abused individuals. Equality Act would eliminate the differentiation between males and females and expose the most battered women to mentally ill males who believe they are women and should have access to shelters limited to female women. This will harm Christian charity and put at risk the Hope Houses we support in ministry. The houses are sex segregated because of the trauma of abuse from men. Being required to house men in our women's shelters would harm our ability to disciple the women in a spiritually safe environment.

This act if passed will allow boys into girl lockerrooms, changing rooms, bathrooms. Men into women's spaces as well. This act requires me and disciples of Jesus to treat the body as though it is nothing holy, disregarding our private reproductive organs as being pointless rather than as they are, holy. This act would require us to no longer teach shame of being naked in front of the opposite sex. This teaches LGBTQ religious beliefs which teach people have NO SHAME for being naked in front of others, which means they hold NOTHING AS HOLY and is an abomination codified into law.

As a licensed minister in the Christian faith, when I organize children's ministry events, we may need to segregate them for specific reasons. We will not recognize a boy who asserts an identity as a girl, this is sin. Our ministry building will have segregation of sexes for bathrooms and locker rooms, and there is no way that we will comply with this act if it were to become law. This act would irreparably harm our ability to disciple our children in our faith and provide pastoral services to them in alignment with our faith.

Adoption and Foster Care

The Equality Act will eliminate Christian charity from Adoption and Foster Care services. As the Christian faith calls us to take care of orphans, Christian adoption charities would be forced to place children into lgbtq centered families which is not in the child's best interest. This would also create a religious test for parents adopting or fostering kids, introducing discrimination against Christian parents who would never pledge to raise a child as transgender if the child were to identify as such but would rather seek treatment to help the child align their identity with the reality of their biological sex..

Claims of discrimination prevents full participation in society and free flow of commerce are false.

(4) Women also have faced discrimination in many establishments such as stores and restaurants, and places or establishments that provide other goods or services, such as entertainment or transportation, including sexual harassment, differential pricing for substantially similar products and services, and denial of services because they are pregnant or breastfeeding."

“Regular and ongoing discrimination against LGBTQ people, as well as women, in accessing public accommodations contributes to negative social and economic outcomes”

The Equality Act relates LGBTQ suffrage with women’s suffrage of the past. However, they are erasing the very women they claim suffered with this act, thereby nullifying the basis for their argument because they are no longer able to define a woman. The definition of a woman is of course AN ADULT FEMALE HUMAN. However the Equality Act will effectively remove all rational means by which to define a woman. The statement that women get pregnant or breastfeeding for example is a biased and bigoted statement to many in the LGBTQ community, assuming the gender identity of “people with wombs” or people “capable of breastfeeding” is in fact female.

Equality Act wrongly categorizes LGBTQ as a class of consumers

As previously stated, LGBTQ is not a protected class and cannot be because it is not immutable. All available science shows sexual orientation is fluid and people can and do experience change in sexual orientation. Who someone sodomizes or whatever gender they want to identify as does not categorize them as a protected consumer group. The Equality Act would wrongly codify the LGBTQ as an immutable ‘group’ which has no actual test to prove someone is in the protected class, except by self assertion.

The Equality Act claims constitutional rights to Sodomy and Gender Identity

Our Constitution was created to protect the unalienable rights given to us from our Creator and to punish evil. It is plainly evident that our Creator did not introduce sodomy or the false and disordered notion gender identity is somehow separate of ones biological sex. Such an idea is fully sourced from the vain imaginations of man in rebellion to their Creator. Sodomy is harmful to the body, mind, and soul and is unnatural, disordered from what is natural for human kind. Sodomy is unbecoming and a dehumanizing behavior, historically used to shame and emasculate men. Transgender beliefs also dehumanize the individual by claiming their body is out of alignment with their beliefs, rather than their beliefs are simply delusional and disordered. It is plainly evident our founding fathers, nor our Creator, provides constitutional rights to sodomy or gender identity.

There is no definition of ‘conversion therapy’ as it is a catch all phrase for anything that the LGBTQ community believes is contradictory to their religious beliefs that one is born gay and cannot change, nor should anyone not want to sodomize someone or be in a romantic relationship with someone of the same sex. The attack on ‘conversion therapy’ by the LGBTQ lobby has GROSSLY proven itself, world wide, to be an attack on religious beliefs. We’ve seen Australia threaten ministers of the Gospel of Jesus Christ with 10 years in jail and 100k fine just for calling homosexuality a sin and leading a sodomite in a prayer of repentance asking God to cleanse their heart and heal their mind. We’ve seen Canada pass their C4 bill in January outlawing Christian teaching on the sin of sodomy (homosexuality) and cross dressing / presenting as the other sex, both abominations. In a show of solidarity with the churches in Canada which lost their freedom to preach the Gospel truth around Biblical Sexuality, thousands of pastors in the US preached against the teachings of the LGBTQ cult beliefs and the tyranny of Canadian lawmakers who unanimously passed the bill to roaring applause. The Government of the United States has no Constitutional power to determine the outcome of ‘sense of self worth’ for any of her citizens. Self worth is strictly in the realm of religion. This act would prohibit anyone who wants to follow Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior from seeking assistance to leave the abusive LGBTQ cult to follow Jesus. The Equality Act creates a religious mandate by the government that anyone who has been groomed into the LGBTQ community must stay there and cannot leave, cannot seek assistance to leave, and is presuming that every single LGBTQ community member enjoys being there and feels a ‘sense of self worth’ in that community.

It is important to note that the LGBTQ individual already undermines their self worth by submitting to unnatural acts (sodomy) or appropriating a gender that is not congruent with the reality of their sex. What is natural is self-evident in natural law, something the United States recognizes. It is self-evident that humans are made male and female by their creator, with the differences intended to draw them together for procreation of the human species. Homosexuality and transgenderism is counter to that which is plainly evident in nature, it is unnatural and not in the best interest of the state to promote as normal. To promote homosexuality and transgenderism beliefs as normal and protect it from any criticism is to do a great harm to the country by establishing a state religion.

Having spoken to many people who have left the LGBTQ cult community and experienced significant change in sexual orientation, I believe the claims of suicide and substance abuse are coping mechanisms resulting from trauma or other unmet needs. The state pushing unnatural behaviors, such as sodomy, where a persons body is abused by another, will only exaherbate the issue because that is damaging to the psyche and soul. While the abused may feel in the time it is 'love', my experience being out of the LGBTQ community and receiving healing helped me realize it is actually dehumanizing and adding to the trauma they've already experienced. It is my belief they need help to know the natural and healthy way to relate to the same sex, to have their intimacy needs met in healthy platonic ways, not in sexual ways. As to transgenderism, the suicide and substance abuse is of course related to the practical issue of rejecting one's own body as a coping mechanism for severe trauma.

There is no second class status - but rather the government would be correct in rejecting the harmful religious beliefs that sodomy or transgenderism is beneficial to society. It is the behaviors that are repugnant to nature and an abomination to our Creator. These people were not designed to be so dehumanized but were made for procreation. They have brought themselves low, such harm was not the result of society not embracing them. The government should hold the line on what is true - male and females are the only genders and the only combination for procreation and marriage. This is beneficial for a stable society.

For many of us, we concluded the LGBTQ cult community was a despot community full of bitter people, rapists, and abusers. Wanting out of that community we found peace in Jesus Christ. Yet this Equality Act would label such a conversion out of LGBTQ as “conversion therapy” and criminalize it and deny our Constitutional rights.

Equality Act conflates immutable sex with non-immutable sexual orientation or gender identity beliefs statements then wrongly invokes 14th Amendment

“undermines national progress toward equal treatment regardless of sex, sexual orientation, or gender identity; and (C) is inconsistent with the constitutional principle of equal protection under the Fourteenth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States.”

Sex is immutable. Sexual orientation or gender identity are behaviors and beliefs, harmful ones at that, and when they cross religious boundaries with other citizens, they do not have the right to deny association or government preference of their beliefs. Therefore having federal funds tied to a religious belief in sexual orientation and gender identity fails the lemon test / establishment of a religion test. The government should not choose for people these religious views.

The fourteenth amendment applies to immutable traits of people, not asserted beliefs that can change over time. If the 14th amendment applied 'equal' to every belief system, we would cease to have any definition on which to distinguish good from bad, allowing for evil, of which the government is created to protect our inalienable rights and punish evil. This Equality Act would make the gospel of and the work of Jesus Christ “evil”, and make sodomy and transgender beliefs good.

Equality Act implements secular humanist beliefs for the entire country

Discrimination based on sexual orientation includes discrimination based on an individual's actual or perceived romantic, emotional, physical, or sexual attraction to other persons, or lack thereof, on the basis of gender. LGBTQ people, including gender nonbinary people, also commonly experience discrimination because of sex-based stereotypes. Many people are subjected to discrimination because of others' perceptions or beliefs regarding their sexual orientation. Even if these perceptions are incorrect, the identity imputed by others forms the basis of discrimination.

The Christian faith believes that mankind exists in a sex binary, male and female, and that marriage is naturally defined as between a male and a female, and that children have the right to be raised by their biological mother and father. The Equality Act specifically defines discrimination of LGBTQ people based on the individuals belief of romantic, emotional, physical, or sexual attraction, or lack thereof. These are most definitely NOT immutable traits of a person but metaphysical and philosophical questions of religion. If the discrimination is defined by religious terms, then the test for discrimination becomes a religious test the government must administer to determine if an act was criminal or not. The United States Government has no power or authority to determine such claims of harm. Additionally, it is scientifically true and naturally self evident that humans exist in two genders and there is no such thing as non-binary. If you were to examine the bodily remains of a non-binary individual you would identify them as either female or male. The act drastically pulls on secular humanism as a basis for discrimination, making the government an judge of religious sins and religious penance.

Authors of the Equality Act call evil good and good evil

Numerous provisions of Federal law expressly prohibit discrimination on the basis of sex, and Federal courts and agencies have correctly interpreted these prohibitions on sex discrimination to include discrimination based on sexual orientation, gender identity, and sex stereotypes.

Governments are instituted to punish evil. This bill flips what has traditionally been good and calls it evil, and now codifies what is evil as good.

The authors are incorrect in claiming federal courts and agencies have correctly interpreted items when it comes to the definition of sex. In fact, any time sexual orientation or gender identity is claimed by a

federal court or agency in lieu of 'sex' they are grossly misinterpreting the meaning of the word sex and applying a religious viewpoint onto something twisting the meaning altogether. Therefore this would be better stated as WRONGLY interpreted the word 'sex'.

The claim that they correctly interpreted is bad conclusion because SEX is immutable, and who you sodomize is a choice, and which gender identity you assert is a religious belief, not a statement of fact. The authors and interpreters are conflating behaviors and desires with immutable language of 'sex'. This is the result of decades of propaganda from the LGBTQ cult slowly moving the culture away from behavior and choice to a core 'being' belief and the belief in orientation immutability.

The Equality Act will force Churches to hire LGBTQ individuals, regardless of faith alignment

This Act makes explicit that existing Federal statutes prohibiting sex discrimination in employment (including in access to benefits), healthcare, housing, education, credit, and jury service also prohibit sexual orientation and gender identity discrimination.

(b) Purpose.--It is the purpose of this Act to expand as well as clarify, confirm and create greater consistency in the protections and remedies against discrimination on the basis of all covered characteristics and to provide guidance and notice to individuals, organizations, corporations, and agencies regarding their obligations under the law.

(b) Unlawful Employment Practices.--Section 703 of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42 U.S.C. 2000e-2) is amended-- (1) in the section header, by striking ``sex," and inserting ``sex (including sexual orientation and gender identity),";

This Equality Act would treat sexual orientation and gender identity as an immutable trait and require churches, among any other organization, to hire LGBTQ identified individuals. This means that as a minister I would be required to hire people who have a different faith than I do, harming my ability to operate in the Christian faith as authentically and effectively as I desire.

The act claims a redress of harm to the LGBTQ individual, however the so-called redress of harm creates harm in the other direction - against our First Amendment rights and free speech rights and freedom of association. Any redress of harm toward lgbtq beliefs (again, they aren't an immutable group) harms others who hold beliefs contrary to LGBTQ. This includes Jewish, Catholic, Christian, and Muslim beliefs. This would institute secular humanism as the government established religion for the country.

The Equality Act will harm my ability to receive fair and equal treatment in a jury

LGBTQ people by their religious beliefs deny the Creator, and therefore are unfit to judge anyone. Since they cannot judge natural law, how can they judge their neighbors? They are unfit for jury duty. This law would put those who reject the Creator and our inalienable rights in place of judgement of American citizens, likely denying them their inalienable rights in preference to their cult belief in capricious human rights as defined by them rather than the Creator.

The LGBTQ cult religion has proven to be bigoted and hateful toward former LGBTQ members as evidenced by the 'conversion therapy ban' narratives and gross attacks on the former LGBTQ community I and others have experienced. Not being able to dismiss LGBTQ identified individuals from jury duty would harm former LGBTQ members should they be required to have a jury. Our rights demand a fair trial free from biased and bigoted individuals judging us.

The Equality Act wrongly associates same-sex couples as capable and virtuous as parents

Although same-sex couples are 7 times more likely to foster or adopt than their different-sex counterparts, many child-placing agencies refuse to serve same-sex couples and LGBTQ individuals. This has resulted in a reduction of the pool of qualified and available homes for youth in the child welfare system who need placement on a temporary or permanent basis. It also sends a negative message about LGBTQ people to children and youth in the child welfare system about who is, and who is not, considered fit to be a parent.

As mentioned previously, what 'qualifies' someone to be a parent is what is natural to mankind, being a father or a mother. The LGBTQ lobby has worked tirelessly to eliminate father and mother from our vocabulary, yet I will bring it back.

The act states that same-sex couples are 7 times more likely to 'foster or adopt' than their different-sex counterparts, which may or may not be true, but regardless is obviously not because they are more qualified or virtuous, but because they literally cannot produce children. Same-sex couples are literally unable to create children by the nature of their disordered relationship.

It is a false claim to argue that eliminating same-sex couples from the 'pool' of available 'parents' is discriminatory. Never in history has a same-sex couple been able to parent children, and their assertion that they are 'equal' to opposite-sex parents is an abomination to what is observable in natural law. The authors of the act have pulled out of thin air an implied virtue and ability for same-sex couples to parent children. They are not parents, they are simply guardians. And it is not in the best interest to let children be raised by individuals who deny the natural order and our Creator. They would, by their religious beliefs, teach the child religious beliefs that would undermine the Constitution and our inalienable rights.

This act desires to increase the pool by lowering the standards, or rather completely undefining the standards, of what is best for children, to INCLUDE those who are by nature excluded from child rearing and promote the trafficking of children to create families. This act requires society to act as though children have no interest in being raised by both a father and mother type, to deny the value of having both male/masculine and female/feminine influences in their life. The solution to growing the pool of qualified homes is to find more qualified individuals, not lower the standards. Same sex individuals have no contribution to make to healthy parenting and this argument is detrimental to the health of children. Natural law denies homosexuals parenthood. Parenthood requires a father and a mother. Homosexual relationships deny at least one of these roles to a child and that is harmful to them. I suggest you review the tragic stories of children raised in the LGBTQ cult religion.

The Equality Act codifies in Civil Rights Act discrimination religious observers

(a) Prohibition on Discrimination or Segregation in Public Accommodations.--Section 201 of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42 U.S.C.2000a) is amended-- (1) in subsection (a), by inserting ``sex (including sexual orientation and gender identity),'' before ``or national origin''.

Directly adding in sexual orientation and gender identity (non-immutable traits) into the Civil rights act, the act thereby installs the religious beliefs that homosexuality is immutable and cannot change,

and that gender identity is a form of 'being' the other sex. It prohibits religious belief that sodomy and presenting as the opposite sex is a sin. This would harm my ability to effectively minister in my faith tradition.

The Equality Act codifies in Civil Rights Act the requirement to teach LGBTQ cult beliefs to children

SEC. 5. DESEGREGATION OF PUBLIC EDUCATION. (a) Definitions.--Section 401(b) of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42 U.S.C. 2000c(b)) is amended by inserting "(including sexual orientation and gender identity)," before "or national origin".

Modifying the Civil Rights act will require all educational institutions, including private and home school, to teach LGBTQ cult religious beliefs. I do not want to teach my children that abomination is normal and morally acceptable. Any public education my children attend they will be indoctrinated into the LGBTQ cult religion against my inalienable rights and the First Amendment.

The Equality Act abolishes bona fide occupational qualifications by sex harming Churches

(3) in subsection (e)(1), by striking "enterprise," and inserting "enterprise, if, in a situation in which sex is a bona fide occupational qualification, individuals are recognized as qualified in accordance with their gender identity,"; and (4) in subsection (h), by striking "sex" the second place it appears and inserting "sex (including sexual orientation and gender identity),".

The equality act eliminates all meaning of sex and the intent of the civil rights act when it comes to bona fide occupational qualifications by sex. This means sports will have no meaningful distinguishing means by which to have 'men' or 'women' categories. Our right to privacy of being searched by the same-sex individual in TSA lines would have no meaning, as a male could search a female if he so identifies as a woman. [TSA searches are unconstitutional] Entertainment companies hiring men for a role would be required to hire a female, as long as she identifies as a man. If I had a male position open at my ministry to hire a male pastor to work with men, and a female open position at my ministry to hire a female pastor to work with women, in accordance with my faith tradition and deeply held religious views, I would be forced to hire the incorrect sex simply because they assert their religious belief that as a male they are really a woman or vice versa. This would be exposing my disciples to sin. This is an abridgement of my freedom of association and right to hire according to my faith under the First Amendment.

The Equality Act establishes a religious cult belief of 'gender identity'

(2) Gender identity.--The term "gender identity" means the gender-related identity, appearance, mannerisms, or other gender-related characteristics of an individual, regardless of the individual's designated sex at birth.

The use of this term forces every citizen, against many of our religious beliefs, to subscribe to secular humanism.

An individual's sex is not designated (appointed) at birth. Their sex is observed and recorded as a fact. Our sex is a matter of fact, not opinion or religious belief that is assigned or designated to an individual. One's sex is an immutable and inalienable truth. One cannot change their sex. Gender identity belief system does believe that one can change their sex as seen by all the state identity cards and passports that now allow non-binary options for 'sex' other than (M)ale or (F)emale.

Gender identity is grossly a metaphysical belief. It is untestable and unprovable by scientific methods except by the assertion of an individual. Regardless of 'professional' opinion, gender identity that is incongruent with one's biological sex is a delusion and illness and not normal. Establishing this in the law establishes secular humanism religion.

"Gender identity", and the "appearance", "mannerisms", or other gender-related characteristics is not defined, but completely subjective. What one individual thinks is one appearance or mannerism related to 'women' may as much be associated with 'men' by another individual. This definition creates chaos as it cannot define anything as being related to one's sex. Without any concrete definition, any claim can be made an act of discrimination as the offense is relative to the one holding to gender identity religious beliefs.

Can men talk with their hands, yes. Can men speak softly, yes. The LGBTQ community states gender is a social construct, yet if it is social that means it can change frequently. What is culturally an appearance or mannerism for men today may have been quite different 50 years ago or 50 years from now. More evidence that this act is based on subjective components which make up the definitions of 'gender identity'. This act therefore relegates the average citizen to be imprisoned by these false beliefs.

This Act Codifies Same Sex Marriage and requires people of faith to perform marriages

Should I be asked to marry a couple, and I know they are biologically the same sex, or that they are living as the opposite sex, I will not marry them. This act, if passed, would cause my religious convictions to be criminalized. This is evident in many court cases where LGBTQ lobby activists intentionally targets Christians in certain industries or situations to create precedent in the courts for discrimination against them.

This Act Codifies the false religious beliefs of 'pregnant men', 'breastfeeding fathers', 'women with penises', and 'men with vaginas'

(4) Sex.--The term `sex' includes-- ``(A) a sex stereotype; ``(B) pregnancy, childbirth, or a related medical condition; ``(C) sexual orientation or gender identity; and ``(D) sex characteristics, including intersex traits.


